Subject: Motion to Adjourn my pending 'Probation violation hearing' before Hon. Craig U. Dana,  
J.M.C. in the Township of Green until after I return from approved travel to Nevada by Superior Court

Judge N. Peter Conforti, J.S.C. on or about Jun 30, 2009 which was also approved by the Sussex County Assistant Prosecutor Joseph Corazza on May 27, 2009, other filing matters regarding my two Municipal Appeals in the Superior Court in Sussex County of 14 convictions by Judge Dana in State of New Jersey v. Thomas Caggiano, my two municipal appeals filed in Superior Court Sussex County and one in Mercer County Superior Court based upon my conviction by Trenton Municipal Judge Sancinito, C.J.M.C. on a harassment charge brought against me by the Borough of Stanhope's accomplice GRC's Catherine Stargill, Affidavits of Probable Cause Filings vs. dozens of persons in Morristown municipal court based upon Borough of Stanhope v. GRC and Thomas Caggiano changed Docket SSX-L-847-07 purpose and other matters

a. Hon. Thomas V. Manahan, P.J.S.C. Court Order, May 19, 2009 to all municipal judges in the Morris County / Sussex County Vicinage filed under State of New Jersey v. Thomas Caggiano, Sussex County Superior Court Ind. No. 08-09-00316-I

b. The CAG Report, May 25, 2009, entitled; The Tyranny of Government is exposed on ThomasCaggiano.com

c. Sussex County Prosecutor Complementary Investigation Report, Case ID: 03-I-00086 by Detective Costello, Feb 13, 2003 meeting between Thomas Caggiano and Sussex County Prosecutor where Thomas Caggiano reported that E.N.F. Development Co. LLC. had NO State certified Soil Erosion and Sediment Control Plan required to be certified by the Department of Agriculture's Sussex County Soil Conservation District and approved by the Borough of Stanhope's Board of Adjustment for a Minor Sub-division prior to starting development of the Project Block 10902 Lots 10 and 12 which also had a wetland permit issued requiring compliance with the State Soil Erosion and Sediment Control Act, Map Filing Law requiring approval of maps and plans by an authorized Borough Engineer or Municipal Engineer hired in accordance with the Local Public Contracts Law, required notification of any changes in drawings and plans by the developer to the Department of Environmental Protection for approval and compliance with the Borough of Stanhope municipal codes such as Chap 100, Land Development, Chap 53 Shade Tree Commission and other laws and regulations.

c. The CAG Report, Jan 8, 2008 provided to the Mercer Superior Court Judge Neil H. Shuster, J.S.C. and other defendants exhibits provided thereafter to prevent an illegal Chancery Division court order finally issued by another Superior Court Judge over Thomas Caggiano's objections and rebuttal that the statements made by Superior Court Judge Maria M. Sypek, P.J.Ch. were false and misleading and the court order issued on May 7, 2009 was unconstitutional and also violated the Open Public Meeting Act, Open Public Record Act, Common law Right to Know and Federal Communications law. In addition a recent decision by the New Jersey Appellate Court to improve transparency of Government as stated in the legislative purpose of the Open Public Record Act was violated by the request by the GRC OPRA executive director Catherine Starghill, Esq. the executive director of the GRC and the New Jersey Attorney General Anne Milgram and its Office of Attorney General's Division of Law DAG Debra Allen, Esq.. The GRC lawyers Debra Allen, Esq. and In-house lawyer Karyn Gordon, Esq. and executive director Catherine Starghill, Esq. originally requested a three day restraining order as stated by Debra Allen to prevent Thomas Caggiano from attending an Open Public Record Council Meeting in the State's Department of Community Affairs Building wherein Thomas Caggiano formal complaints against the Office of the Attorney General's Department of Consumer Affairs and the Borough of Stanhope for denial of access to Government Records within the Board of Engineers and the Board of Professional Planners which were provided complaints by Thomas Caggiano, Mary Pawar and Iqbal Pawar against

John Cilo Jr who posed as the Borough of Stanhope's Municipal Engineer without a signed contract for professional services awarded under the exception approved by a resolution by the Governing Body and then negotiated with a signed written contract with a minimum of four criteria stated in the official newspaper meeting the State's Local Public Contract's Law public notice.

d. Letter, from Thomas Caggiano to Government Record Council, Sep 13, 2007 contained within The CAG Report of Jan 8, 2008 and other relevant and pertinent documents therein, Subject: GRC Interlocutory Review pursuant to N.J.A.C. 1.1-14.10(k) of OAL actions under GRC 07725-2007N and the prior GRC 09424N Office of Administrative Law Dockets and the subsequent transfer of 17 OPRA denial of Access from the GRC to the OAL for the stated reason the Catherine Starghill, Esq. had a conflict of interest with Thomas Caggiano as she had filed a complaint with the Trenton Municipal Court. Before any Dependent portion of the Trial was initiated by Judge Louis Sancinito and while the case was still ripe, the GRC without sending per Thomas Caggiano as requested an advanced copy of the GRC agendas in violation of the OPEN Public Record Act directed the OAL while Thomas Caggiano was wrongfully imprisoned as inmate from Jan 7, 2009 to Apr 1, 2009 and suffered bodily harm requiring emergency hospitalization on Jan 8-9, 2009 with medical treatments thereafter for over two months as warnings were provided by his primary doctor to allow Mr. Caggiano to leave the State of New Jersey and the United States of America. Once released from Jail, Mr. and Mr. Caggiano arranged an eight day cruise to the Bahamas to seek medical rest from trauma and both began medical treatments by multiple doctors as known by the Probation Services Department.

e. The CAG Report of May 13, 2007 provided the GRC in an Open Public Meeting of the GRC by Thomas Caggiano.

f. Thomas Caggiano Letter, Feb 3, 2006 to the Office of the Attorney General's Department of Consumer Affairs' Board of Engineers with ninety exhibit's in response to the Office of the Attorney General's Division of Law's Michelle Albertson direction to Thomas Caggiano at the formal investigative inquiry on Feb 2, 2006,, Complaint # 05-13 against John Cilo Jr. of John Cilo Jr. Associates who represented himself to the public that he was the municipal engineer of the Borough of Stanhope and that his companies paid employee, Scarlet Doyle, a professional planner was the Borough of Stanhope's Town Planner with a signed contract awarded per the State's Local Public Contract Law through the firm John Cilo Jr. Associates or her own written contract.

g. Thomas Caggiano, Sep 24, 2002, 41 exhibit presentation provided to the Mayor of Stanhope, Town Council, Borough Attorney Richard Stein of Laddey, Clark and Ryan LLC concerning the illegal development of the Minor Sub-division, Block 10902 Lots 10 and 12 and a petition signed by fourteen property owners surrounding the Minor Sub-division, Tax Block Map of Block 10902, Site plan approved by Board of Adjustment and John Cilo Jr. who represented himself as the Borough Engineer which was also a Soil Erosion and Sediment Control Plan Never certified by the State Soil Conservation District as required by the State's Soil Erosion and Sediment Control Act and other State laws and Stanhope's Land Development Code, certified Soil Erosion and Sediment Control Plan for only Lot 10 Block 10902 certified by Sussex County Soil Conservation District and Thomas Caggiano successful third party appeal to the State's Sussex County Soil Conservation Committee as confirmed in writing by the executive secretary James Sadley the superior of Clifford Lundin, Esq. who signed the Soil Erosion and Sediment Control Plan ruled invalid as it was NOT for the complete two lot project. Block 10902 Lots 10 and 12, 2 Oak Drive and 6 Oak Drive.

n. Letter signed May 8, 2006 by fifteen property owners to the Borough of Stanhope to comply with federal, state and municipal laws on the illegal developments by E.N.F. Development Co. LLC on Block 10902 Lots 10 and 12 and Block 10903 Lots 13 and 14 (sic Lot 15 which is not E.N.F. Development Co. LLC. property) and deny Lot Area variance do to the developers non-compliance with laws and adverse impacts to private property and violations of safety laws and other laws.

Letter from State President Senator Richard Codey Office to Mark ( sp Thomas ) Caggiano that the materials ( box with documents and audio recordings), Nov 11, 2004 of alleged corruption in the Borough of Stanhope was forwarded by Senator Codey's office to Office of Government Integrity, P.O. Box 063, Trenton, N.J. 08625 and to direct comments or additional documentation to the OGI, signed Erin K. O'Gara-Meier. This large amount of evidence and related material was presented also to the U.S. Attorney's Office, Newark, New Jersey wherein its Staff member Stan Beet, now a member of the Department of Law and Public Safety screamed at the Special Prosecutor's office James Nobile for U.S. Attorney Chris Christie stating in my presence: "How can't you investigate?".during my two hour presentation.

1. Attached for your records and appropriate actions with the New Jersey Attorney General and others copied herein are copies of my records of Affidavits of Probable Cause I signed under oath in the Township of Green against various parties and corporations.

2. As my wife Kathryn Caggiano continues to be suffering great emotional trauma do to my prior unconstitutional convictions and sentencing by many municipal judges on petty disorder charges, extended wrongful imprisonment, sustained emotional distress caused by crimes against my civil rights,

kidnapping, wrongful arrest, slander, libel, defamation of my character in an orchestrated, coordinated enterprise and repeated pattern by dozens of public officials, and others we simply seek silence for a month while we search for our home in Nevada.

3. Please take appropriate actions while we are away are seeking a new home in the State of Nevada do to lower taxes, drier sunny weather which is better for our health do to our medical conditions as we are senior citizens, less traffic congestion, lower property tax, no State income tax, better quality life with near National Park as many dozens of witnesses and expected defendants noted on my authored and published web site ThomasCaggiano.com that has been filed with Sussex County Superior Court and the Sussex County Prosecutor's Office which per the definition in Title 2C is the "Attorney General".

4. Noted in the attached correspondence are thousands of records, audio recordings and other witnesses that I suggest no longer be ignored by the State and municipality and that a recovery plan be reviewed by appropriate parties to lessen the burden upon the people of Sussex County and the State of New Jersey as I expect to file if needed over a hundred Affidavits of Probable Cause against those identified in my published web site ThomasCaggiano.com and the criminal tip line reports that fill cabinet draws in the Office of Attorney General's Department of Law and Public Safety, Official Corruption Bureau, Office of Government Integrity, the Department of Community Affairs, Department of Agriculture, FBI, U.S. Attorney and its courts and many municipalities.. Dozens of favorable Witnesses noted there-in abound.
