The Government Record Council's executive director Catherine Starghill, Esq. the Operations Manager Gloria Luzatto, the GRC panel excluding the former excellent

GRC chairman Vince Maltese, Esq. who recused himself and directed the GRC panel and its staff to report Title 2C criminal violations. The GRC without analysis or any hearing before the Government Record Council either Administratively closed dozens of my valid complaints against the Borough of Stanhope for denial of access. On the court records in the Office of Administrative Law the former Town Administrator Teri Massood admitted she willfully destroyed Government Records evidence and the former Municipal Clerk Battaglia admitted in the corrupt hearing by OAL Judge J. Howard Solomon, ALJ she refused to provide copies of any Government Record on the illegally developed minor sub-divison in Stanhope, Block 10902 Lots 10 and 12.

In Trenton's municipal court on a malicious petty disorder complaint filed by Catherine Starghill, Esq. she committed perjury.

In the Joint Municipal Court of the Township of Green the Borough Attorney Richard Stein committed willful perjury by stating falsely the Borough of Stanhope provided copies of all documents requested which is false.

In the Morristown Superior Court in a conspiracy among the GRC and the Borough of Stanhope, a docket was changed denying any access to examine any Government Record in the Borough of Stanhope by the conspirator Judge Bozonnelis, AJSC.

Over 10,000 pages of evidence were provided the Department of Community Affairs. The web site ThomasCaggiano.com was filed in Superior Court n motions as Defendant's voluntary continuing disclosure. All documents within the Department of Community Affairs, the Department of Law and Public Safety, Div of Law as the Deputy Attorney General Debra Allen, Esq. also participated in the cover-up and conspiracy detailed on the filed web site and in motions to the Sussex County Superior Court, the Mercer County Superior Court and all documents provided these courts is adopted as referenced exhibits in this certified affidavit per N. J. Court rules.

The New Jersey Superior Court - Criminal Part has issued court orders as noted on my internet published web site ThomasCaggiano.com and are included as a part of this certified affidavit including all records provided in my appearances at the Newark Office of Administrative Law.

Whereas the Bail for the indictment against me brought by the State of New Jersey on behalf of more then a dozen corrupt Stanhope officials and employees, that all fines imposed by Judge Dana were demanded to be immediately return by the Superior Court which also issued a Superior Court finding in agreement with my lawyer Robert Mattia, Esq. who filed many motions in the municipal court against Judge Dana's improper conduct and his illegal sentencing which has been determined by the Superior Court of New Jersey and in agreement with my lawyer and representatives of the Office of the Attorney General of the State of New Jersey being the Assistant Prosecutor and/or State Sussex County Prosecutor, I request ALL Denials of Access of ALL Thomas Caggiano v. the Borough of Stanhope be reconsidered and that an actual hearing with testimony be conducted in the Department of Community Affairs building.

Furthermore, based upon the Appellate court ruling against the Government Record Council in that OPRA requests may be made by email, the GRC and Department of

Community Affairs shall allow such OPRA requests to be made to all custodians within the Department of Community Affairs including the GRC.

Since I was examined by two different doctors from the Department of Health based upon Superior Court orders and both State Department doctors have issued findings that I am NOT a threat to myself, any other person or private property, I request full access to all Open Public Meetings within the Department of Community Affairs. Please note, this finding was also made by my own voluntarily retained doctors.

Attached for the record is a photograph digital image of the filed web site for information as all data on all its links are included by reference including a DVD of evidence provided the Sussex County Superior Court - Criminal Part and Sussex County Prosecutor's Office which contains more than six CDs of relevant data to prove there was a criminal conspiracy to impeded justice and breach of duty, outrageous conduct causing great emotion distressed occurred. Affidavits of Probable Cause were witnessed by the court administrator based upon complaints by Kathryn Caggiano and myself in the Township of Green. Other Affidavits of Probable Cause were issued against dozens of persons in the municipal courts in Newton and Morristown, New Jersey. All those signed court affidavits are made part of this reconsideration complaint including all evidence I provided as Defendant's Disclosure in Trenton's Mercer Superior Court on deceptive affidavits by the GRC personal. Dara Lownie is an excellent case manager, under great mental injury and her depositions should be taken with care. My wife and I wish her the very best. In addition, the former OPRA custodian Ms. Robin Kline, MAS, RMC was under great duress and she has suffered great emotional distress. The original Statements of Information were prepared as she was a new employee and believed the corrupt Borough of Stanhope Borough Attorney Richard Stein who committed perjury in signing those Statement of Information. I therefore request triple fines be imposed by the New Jersey Attorney General as permitted by law and other fines be sought against those who have used the State to foster tyranny against WE the People
